# STUDENT SUCCESS TUTORIAL CENTER

The primary function of the Student Success Tutorial Center is to provide individual or small-group tutoring to any student who needs and wants to improve his/her class performance. Students may apply for tutoring at any time during the semester, but the sooner, the better the opportunity to make significant improvements in your study.

## WHERE ARE WE?



The SS Tutorial Center is east of the main library in room LI-134.

## WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

All students who are currently enrolled at any of the campuses of the State Center Community College District are eligible.

## WHAT'S IT COST?

It's Free! You need only to give up your time and cooperation.

## WHAT DO I DO?

Simply come to the Tutorial Center with your FCC Library card and sign-up. Each tutor has a schedule with his/her available hours. Tutoring is on the first come first served basis. You will be entered in Supervised Tutoring 300 (0 units), which will appear on your schedule. It will not appear on your transcript. Tutors are available for most classes.

## HOW LONG CAN I STAY?

In order to be fair to all students, sessions are limited to no more than one hour and multiple sessions and/or excessive use in a one day period is generally not allowed. Walk-ins are welcome at any time, subject to the availability of the tutors.

## WHO ARE THE TUTORS?

Undergraduate students that are currently enrolled in at least 12 units may be tutors if they meet the requirements established.

Student tutors may work up to nineteen hours per week on campus.

## DO I GET PAID?

Students are paid for the hours they tutor. The pay rate is the same as the established rate of pay for all student jobs on campus. Perhaps of equal importance is the satisfaction that you will feel from helping fellow students achieve the academic success they desire.

## HOW DO I GET STARTED?

Apply at the Student Success Tutorial Center the first week of each new semester. We are always looking for good tutors. A good candidate would be academically competent in one or more subject areas and have the personal qualities of a good teacher. An instructor's recommendation also required.
