

Planning Agendas

The following planning agenda will form the core and provide direction for development of the 2005-2010 institutional strategic plan.

Standard IA and IB

1. Begin the development of Fresno City College's 2005-2010 strategic plan utilizing a collaborative process involving all constituencies and incorporating the findings of the current self study.

Standard IIA

1. Beginning in Fall 2005, develop a plan to assess the effectiveness of program review and five-year curriculum review processes.
2. Under the leadership of the academic senate and the curriculum committee during the Fall 2005 semester, begin the dialogue regarding outcomes at the program and degree levels.
3. As student learning outcomes continue to be included at the course level, begin the development of a process to measure the achievement of stated outcomes.

Standard IIB

1. Develop a comprehensive plan to improve the college transfer rate.
2. Assess current evaluation methods to better support student development and success.

Standard IIC

Library Services

1. Assess current library services to determine an appropriate level of resource allocation.

Tutorial Services

1. Develop and implement a comprehensive online tutorial system.

Standard IIIA

1. Assess the effectiveness of current staff development activities and use the information in the development and implementation of a staff development plan.
2. Assess current human resource allocation process to develop and implement a human resources plan that is fully integrated with an institutional planning process scheduled to begin Fall 2005.

Standard IIIB

1. Reconvene the facilities and grounds committee representative of all constituent groups for planning, evaluating, and prioritizing physical facilities initiatives.

Standard IIIC

1. Restructure the technology advisory committee with representation of all campus constituencies to update and implement the existing Campus Technology Use Plan that aligns with a campus-wide planning process.

Standard IIID

1. Complete the revision of the Fresno City College Grant Funding Handbook.
2. Provide continuing in-service training to all constituent groups on the Budget Procedures Handbook to increase awareness of the budget process.

Standard IVA and IVB

1. Develop a meaningful structure and procedure for shared decision making to ensure that all constituent groups have significant involvement in decisions that affect them.
